

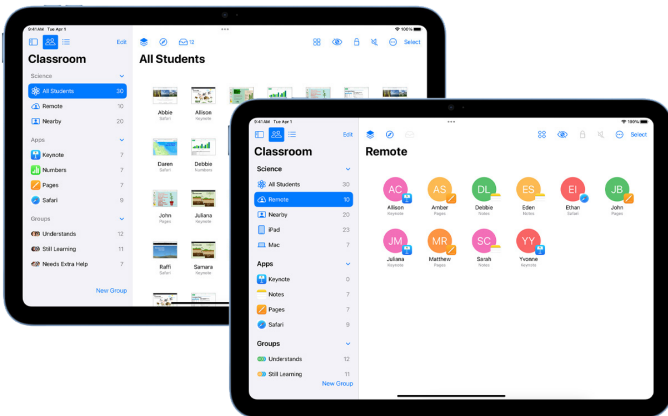


Getting started with Classroom App

Classroom is an app for teachers on iPad and Mac that works like a digital teaching assistant – allowing teachers to guide learning, view student screens, launch apps or webpages, share student work, and manage shared iPad environments. It supports in-room, remote, and hybrid teaching models.

Benefits for Education

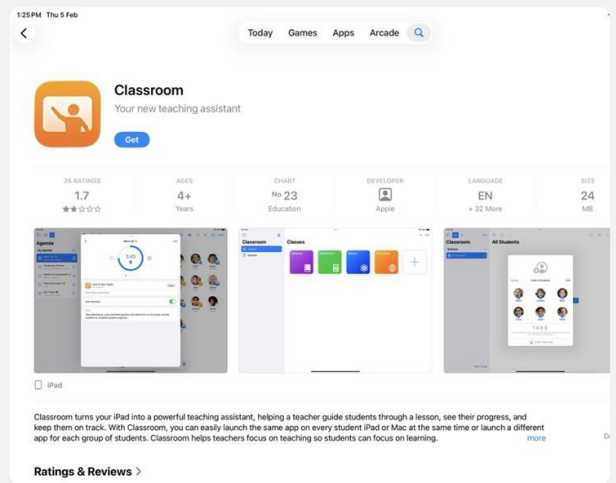
- Helps keep students focused on tasks by allowing teachers to view screens and direct devices to specific apps or content.
- Facilitates structured lessons with agendas and timers, supporting sharing to work displays, and enables summary reports of student activity.
- Provides personalised learning in shared iPad environments.



How is Classroom App used?

- Teachers launch apps, books, and web pages on student devices.
- Send and receive documents, manage passwords, and view usage summaries.
- Manage shared iPad sessions by assigning students to devices and signing them out at the end of class.
- Allows you to see which apps students are working in, and how they have spent their time.

Classroom App Onboarding Steps



1. Download Classroom from the App Store on teacher devices.
2. Classes can be automatically configured via Apple School Manager + Mobile Device Management, or teachers may create classes manually.
3. Students join classes using managed Apple IDs or local codes depending on configuration.
4. Classroom is ready for use in nearby, remote or hybrid environments once rosters are populated.
