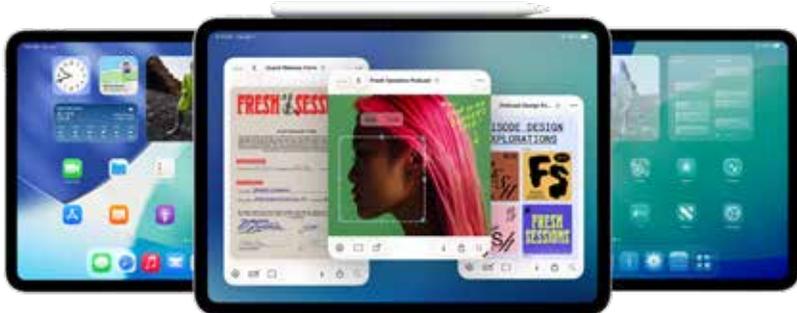


How to Connect

IPAD WI-FI + CELLULAR MODELS

Wi-Fi + Cellular iPad models give you flexibility to stay connected almost anywhere. In addition to standard Wi-Fi access, these models include built in cellular technology, allowing you to use mobile data when Wi-Fi isn't available.

This means you can browse the web, stream content, send emails, and use apps on the go without relying on hotspots. Cellular models support a range of technologies, including 5G for ultra-fast speeds on compatible networks, and they work with eSIM for easy activation without a physical SIM card. Whether you're travelling, working remotely, or need reliable connectivity outdoors, Wi-Fi + Cellular iPad provide seamless internet access wherever coverage exists.



Setting Up Cellular Service on iPad - Wi-Fi + Cellular Models

If you have a Wi-Fi + Cellular iPad, you can sign up to a cellular data plan to stay connected when away from Wi-Fi.

REQUIREMENTS

A SIM and a wireless data plan from a carrier

SUPPORTED SIM TYPES

eSIM

On supported models; not available from all carriers or regions.

Physical SIM

Nano-SIM: on supported models.

Set Up Your eSIM

On supported models you can activate cellular service directly from your iPad.

1. Open Settings > Cellular Data
2. Choose one of the following:
 - **Set up first cellular plan:** Select a carrier and follow onscreen instructions.
 - **Add another plan:** Tap Add a New Plan.
 - **Scan QR code:** Tap Other, then scan the QR code from your carrier or enter details manually. You may need a confirmation code.

To check or change your plan:

Settings > Cellular Data

Alternatively, download your carrier's app from the App Store and activate your plan there.

Note: You can store multiple eSIMs but only use one at a time. Switch plans via Settings > Cellular Data > SIMs.

Install a Physical SIM

For models that support physical SIM:

1. Insert a paper clip or SIM eject tool into the SIM tray hole (usually on the left side).
2. Remove the tray and place the SIM in the correct orientation (angled corner guides you).
3. Reinsert the tray.
4. If prompted, enter your SIM PIN carefully.

Warning: Incorrect guesses can permanently lock your SIM. Contact your carrier if locked.

Manage Cellular Data Service

1. Go to Settings > Cellular Data
2. Enable/disable 5G, LTE, or roaming: Tap Cellular Data Options.
3. Set up Personal Hotspot: Tap Set Up Personal Hotspot (carrier dependent).
4. Manage account: Tap Manage (account name) or Carrier Services.
